All Teams must be USA Hockey registered.

USA Hockey Rosters must be received by September 12th.

POINTS & TIE BREAKERS

POINTS :

Division standings will be determined by points: Each team will receive 2 points for each game won, 1 point for each game tied; 1 point for every period won, 1/2 point for every period tied for maximum of 5 points.

TIEBREAKERS

- 1) Most wins
- 2) Winner of Head to Head Game*
*this tie-breaker does not apply if more than two teams are tied
- 3) $\Delta = \frac{\text{Goals scored} - \text{Goals against}}{\text{Goals against}}$
The highest number wins. 7 goals MAX differential per game used (e.g. 10-1 score=8 Goals scored, 1 Goal against)
- 4) Least goals allowed
- 5) Least total penalty minutes
- 6) First goal scored in head to head game (this tie-breaker does not apply if more than two teams are tied)
- 7) Coin flip
