



Due to the mandate instituted last night by the Frederick County Board of Health, everyone 5 years old and over will be required to wear a mask inside Skate Frederick as of 5pm Friday December 31<sup>st</sup>, regardless of vaccination status. Exceptions can be made for medical conditions. Masks will be required on the ice for public skating sessions and learn to skate classes. Masks will not be required **on the ice** for hockey players and freestyle session skaters.

Additionally, lockers rooms will be closed as of Monday January 3<sup>rd</sup>, until further notice. Players should be prepared to dress in the parking lot before entering the rink.

Skate Frederick remains committed to providing a safe environment and protecting the health of our employees and loyal customers. We will continue to allow time between events, so that our staff can disinfect high touch areas. We appreciate your understanding and support during this stressful time, and hope that these new stipulations will be lifted in the near future. With our combined efforts, we can all remain on the ice safely, and enjoy the sport and exercise we have come to love.
